The Allen Family Scholarship is an annual **\$5,000** award for attendance at an accredited two- or four-year college, university, technical or trade school. It is available to a graduating senior at either Willsboro Central School or Boquet Valley Central School. The scholarship may renew each year, up to three years (with a maximum total of \$20,000), provided the recipient can furnish evidence of working diligently, earning grades that reflect that effort, and making steady and satisfactory progress toward a degree or appropriate certificate.

Applications for 2026 are due no later than May 15th Annually.
